More people stop reading daily because they feel guilty when they miss a day, and then feel overwhelmed when they try to make up time. Don't do it. This is about Grace not Law.
4. If you miss several days in a row you will re-evaluate your priorities. Everyone will miss a day. But if you've missed several, there's something going on in your life you need to figure out. Feel free to talk to Pastor Bill if you would like some assistance in that.
