

SVLC New Testament Tour 2010

February 22nd – Luke 5: Jesus public discourse begins to challenge everybody's thinking and His miracles change lives and upset the balance of "order". Special note – In verses 17-26 which comes first, healing or wholeness?

February 23rd – Luke 6: The Disciples are chosen and we hear Jesus' Sermon on the plain. It's different from the Sermon on the Mount, because there are Blessing and Sorrows here in Luke. We often consider ourselves to be in the first category, but shouldn't neglect to read the second.

February 24th – Luke 7: The first story emphasizes Jesus came for others, and then in the second story Jesus does something very similar to Elijah and Elisha (great Jews). Then it ends with the real reason Jesus came, to forgive the sins of any who ask!

February 25th – Luke 8: Four soils. We've probably been all of them from time to time. Honest evaluation time: Which one are you now?

February 26th – Luke 9: Here's the first big shift in Luke. It signals the end of Jesus' ministry in Galilee, and in verse 51 He begins His long journey to Jerusalem. The Transfiguration on the Mountain is a high, leading to a very long valley below. How many mountain top experiences have you had in your faith?

February 27th – Luke 10: Jesus sent out the 12 last chapter, and the 72 this chapter. Does He ever send them out alone? So, who's your partner in ministry?

February 28th – Luke 11: The Lord's Prayer. Doesn't get much better than this. Also, at the end of the chapter I've underlined what I consider to be one of the greatest warnings for a Pastor. Can you find it?
